

Stax 2021 TruView™

User Guide

What's it for:

TruView allows you to place an image behind your facility views.

- For ramps or campus views this can be handy, particularly for events, to show the ancillary details surrounding your facility.
- For hangar interiors this will allow you to place custom markings on the hangar floor.

How to use it

Create an image:

- For hangars you will use your favorite graphics software.
- For campus views you probably want to take a screenshot of Google Maps or Google Earth.
- To make placing the image as easy as possible, it is important to use an image with the same proportional size as your facility.

Note: Images used must be less than 2MB in size.

Place the image:

- Click the TruView icon at the top of the your facilities screen.
- If your facility does not already have an image background, you will be prompted to choose an image from your local computer.
- After you choose an image or if your facility already has a background image you will be put in Background Editing mode.

In Editing mode, you have 3 checkboxes to turn on or off the display of safety zones and walls and the option to crop your image to size.

To correctly position your background image you can pan, zoom, and rotate your image.

Pan

- Pan by holding down the alt/opt key, drag your mouse or your finger on the track pad. Do not click the mouse button.
- This action lets you move the image up, down, left, or right.

Zoom

- Zoom by using two fingers on the track pad or the mouse scroll wheel to zoom in and out. For fine tuning the zoom, use the alt/opt key and the up or down arrow.

Rotate

- Rotate by holding down the left shift key and use the left, right, up, down arrow to rotate your image by small increments.

Once you have the image correctly positioned and sized, use the Save button to save your layout.

If you are replacing an image currently in use, you must delete the current image first.
